



Extending the Use of Sutton Inclusion Centre CONSULTATION QUESTIONNAIRE

Sutton Inclusion Centre has a range of equipment and facilities that could be used by all people with disabilities in Sutton. The facilities available include:

- An Aqua-Therapy suite
- Sensory rooms
- Physiotherapy Rooms & equipment
- Music, art, and other activity rooms & equipment
- An interactive technology suite
- Kitchen and welcome rooms
- Spaces to relax











Currently the Centre is only used by people with learning disabilities and multiple needs and it is not used its full potential. The Council is consulting with the public about extending the use of the Centre to all people with disabilities and complex needs in Sutton. The Council wants the Centre to be:

A Resource Centre & Community Hub for adults and young people in Sutton who have disabilities or complex needs

Who would be able to use the Centre in the future?

As well as people with learning disabilities and multiple needs all other people in Sutton who have disabilities and/or complex needs would be able to use the Centre. This includes:

- people with learning disabilities who do not have multiple needs;
- people who have physical disabilities and/or complex needs;
- older people who have complex needs including people with dementia;
- children and young people who have disabilities and/or complex needs;
- other people with complex long term conditions.

How much will it cost to use the facilities at the Centre?

The council is also consulting about charges for the hire of rooms and equipment at the Centre. The schedule of costs is available in the full consultation document and the accessible consultation document.

The specialist healthcare services provided by the Council (funded by Sutton CCG) will continue to be free at the point of delivery.

People who are eligible for social care will be able to use their personal budgets to access the facilities at the Centre. Other people will be able to pay to use the facilities via the Council Website or through the administration team at the Centre.

Increasing the range of services and opportunities for people

The Council wants to work in partnership with other organisations to find out what equipment and other facilities would be helpful to enable them to provide services and increase opportunities for people with disabilities and complex needs at the Centre.

How would these proposals affect the people currently using the Centre?

The Centre would provide facilities for all people with disabilities and this would integrate services for people with learning disabilities alongside services for people who do not have learning disabilities. A more inclusive facility for people with learning disabilities and multiple needs would enable greater integration, which would strengthen the links people have with the rest of the community.

People who are currently using the Centre would be protected from charges so that the proposals being made by the Council do not disadvantage them in any way.
