Appendix D

Non-NHS Services



Community pharmacy contractors in Sutton may provide a range of services directly to their customers, which are not commissioned by NHSE, the LA, the CCG or other NHS Services. These are referred to as 'Non-NHS' services within the PNA.

The table below provides a flavour of these non-NHS services, although the scope of the service offered varies from pharmacy to pharmacy. Customers may be required to pay for some for some of these services; however, others may be provided 'free of charge' as a value-added service.
