



Establishment of a SEN Opportunity Base at Avenue Primary School from September 2014

Notice is given in accordance with the relevant sections of the Education Act 1996 and the Education and Inspections Act 2006 as amended by the Education Act 2011 that the London Borough of Sutton intends to make a prescribed alteration to Avenue Primary School, Avenue Road, Sutton, Surrey, SM2 6JE from 1 September 2014.

The proposal is to permanently establish a SEN Opportunity Base to cater for the needs of up to 12 children with learning difficulties at Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1. The School currently has a capacity of 708 places and has 780 children on roll. It admits up to 120 pupils at Reception Year and the pupils admitted to the Base will be in addition to those children. Specialist accommodation will be provided to accommodate the SEN Base which will be available from September 2014. A major building project for the overall expansion of the School and to bring its capacity up to 840 places will be completed by September 2015.
