



Closure of SEN Opportunity Base at Culvers House Primary School

Notice is given in accordance with the relevant sections of the Education Act 1996 and the Education and Inspections Act 2006 as amended by the Education Act 2011 that the London Borough of Sutton intends to make a prescribed alteration to Culvers House Primary School, Orchard Avenue, Mitcham, Surrey, CR4 4JH from 1 September 2014.

The proposal is to close the SEN Opportunity Base which caters for the needs of up to 12 pupils with physical disabilities. The School currently has a capacity of 400 places and has 418 children on roll. It admits up to 60 pupils at Reception Year and the pupils admitted to the Base were in addition to those children. Developments in practice mean that it is no longer necessary to provide a specialist SEN Base for children with physical disabilities because increasingly their local primary school is capable of providing appropriate support for their needs and can offer an appropriate curriculum.
