Subsequent to the approval of the proposal set out in the Notice, it is the intention of the Governing Body, as the Admissions Authority for the School and acting in accordance with the guidance in the School Admissions Code 2010, Section 1.21 to make a request to the Schools Adjudicator to increase the admission number of the school at the relevant year (YR) from 60 to 90 for September 2012.

It is planned to enlarge the physical capacity of the School with additional accommodation for infant aged children being ready by September 2012. Accommodation will be provided in the Junior School for children entering Key Stage 2 from September 2015.
