

Enlargement of School Premises and Increase of Admission Number at St Mary's Catholic Nursery and Infant School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the London Borough of Sutton intends to make a prescribed alteration to St Mary's Catholic Nursery and Infant School, West Street, Carshalton. SM5 2PT from 1 September 2013

The proposal is permanently to enlarge the physical capacity of the School in order to accommodate additional pupils with effect from September 2013. The current capacity of the school is 180 places and the proposed capacity will eventually be 270 places. The current number of pupils registered at the School is 180. The published admissions number for the reception year (YR) intake in September 2013 is 60. It is proposed to increase this to 90. The enlargement of the premises will ensure that the School is able to accommodate 90 pupils at the YR intake point.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Subsequent to the approval of the proposal set out in the Notice, it is the intention of the Governing Body, as the Admissions Authority for the School and acting in accordance to the guidance in the School Admissions Code 2010, Section 1.21 to increase the admission number of the school at the relevant year (YR) from 60 to 90 for September 2013.

It is planned to enlarge the physical capacity of the School with additional accommodation for children in YR being ready by September 2013 and permanent accommodation being provided for Key Stage 1 aged children by September 2014. Accommodation will be provided for children entering Key Stage 2 from September 2016.
