#### 1. INTRODUCTION

This consultation document explains the Local Authority's proposals to close the SEN Opportunity Base at Culvers House Primary School from September 2014. Your views are important to us, so please take the opportunity to express your opinion on the proposals in this document.

#### 3. THE CONSULTATION PROCESS

Publication of this document marks the beginning of the consultation process to close the SEN Opportunity Base at Culvers House Primary School. This document will be made widely available and circulated to all schools and to other statutory consultees. It will also be available via the Council's website <a href="https://www.sutton.gov.uk">www.sutton.gov.uk</a>

The public consultation period will end at 5pm on Friday 14 February 2014. If you wish to express any views or comments on the proposals, please let us have your response by no later than the above time and date. All views and responses will be carefully considered before any further decisions on the proposals are made.

There will be a public consultation meeting arranged to look at the possible closure of the SEN Opportunity Base. The meeting will be open to all parents, along with members of the public who are interested in finding out more about the proposals.

Following the end of this period of public consultation, a report will be submitted to the Council's Children, Family and Education Committee (CFEC) at its meeting on 13 March 2014 which will detail responses received and any issues raised during the consultation period. The CFEC will consider these responses before deciding whether to take the proposals forward through the publication of Statutory Proposals which are formal, legal documents which set out the exact details of the change that is being proposed. Following the publication of the Statutory Proposals, there will be a six week Representation Period during which comments and objections can be made on the proposals

Views expressed in the Representation Period will be considered before a final decision is made. This final decision is likely to be taken during the summer 2014 term.

If a final decision cannot be made at that time, then the proposals will be referred to a third party, the Office of the Schools Adjudicator, which will decide them. There is also some scope for certain interested parties, for example, the governing body of the school to which the proposal relates, to appeal to the Schools Adjudicator following the determination of the Statutory Notice if they disagree with the decision.

#### 5. BACKGROUND

Culvers House Primary School has places for 12 pupils with physical disabilities in the Opportunity Base. Currently there are six pupils with statements of special educational needs who are supported in the Base. In the last two years there have been no admissions into the Base. The School is well adapted to accommodate the needs of pupils with physical difficulties, operates on an inclusive ethos and has been using the resource of the Base to provide individual support in mainstream classes, with withdrawal for therapy. However, other primary schools also have accessible accommodation for children with physical disabilities and these needs are being met by schools near to the child's home in accordance with parental preference. There is no longer a local requirement for specialist provision for primary aged children whose prime need is physical disability.

Discussions have taken place with the School to consider changing the designation of the Base and a visit was made to the Amy Johnson Primary School Base with a view to replicating that model of provision for pupils with learning difficulties. However, it was concluded that the accommodation at Culvers House does not suit that model and the capital cost of adding to the accommodation is prohibitive.

From initial discussions, whilst indicating their support for the recommendation to close the Base, the Governors of Culvers House Primary School have requested that the school's accessibility for children with physical disabilities and its facilities for supporting children with medical needs should be borne in mind when considering mainstream placements for such children.

#### 6. THE PROPOSAL

The proposal is to close the SEN Opportunity Base with effect from September 2014. As far as the funding and provision available to support its current children, the transition should have no impact whatsoever but rather reflect the current practice and organisation of the School and its approach to supporting pupils with SEN.

The Local Authority has a duty under the Education Act 1996 to secure special educational provision for pupils with special educational needs and to keep that provision under review. When proposing any reorganization of SEN provision, Local Authorities are required to apply the 'SEN Improvement Test', i.e. to demonstrate that the proposed alternative arrangements are likely to lead to improvements in the standard, quality and/or range of educational provision for children with special educational needs.

There are currently six children attending the Culvers House Base. Those children would be able to continue their attendance at the school and funding for their additional support would transfer to the SEN Integration Fund (ie individual funding). Future referrals for children who have Statements for SEN arising from physical disabilities would lead to placement at schools near to their home if that is in accordance with parental preference. Otherwise, there are suitable alternatives in schools within Sutton which should be well placed to meet the needs of children with physical disabilities.

In this context, maintaining this unnecessary provision is an unreasonable use of public expenditure which does not represent value for money.
