



## **Significant Enlargement of School Premises and Increase of Admission Number at St Mary's Catholic Junior School**

Notice is given in accordance with the relevant sections of the Education Act 1996 and the Education and Inspections Act 2006 as amended by the Education Act 2011 that the London Borough of Sutton intends to make a prescribed alteration to St Mary's Catholic Junior School, Shorts Road, Carshalton, Surrey. SM5 2PB from 1 September 2015

The proposal is permanently to enlarge the physical capacity of the School in order to accommodate additional pupils with effect from September 2015. The current capacity of the school is 264 places and the proposed capacity will eventually be around 360 places. The current number of pupils registered at the School is 264. The published admissions number for the Year 3 (Y3) intake in September 2015 is 66. It is proposed to increase this to 99. The enlargement of the premises will ensure that the School is able to accommodate 99 pupils at the Y3 intake point.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

Immediately subsequent to the approval of the proposal set out in the Notice, it is the intention of the Governing Body as the Admission Authority for the School to amend the determined admission arrangements at the school and to increase the admission number of the school at the relevant year (Y3) from 66 to 99 with effect from September 2015.

It is planned to enlarge the physical capacity of the School with accommodation for junior aged children being ready by September 2015.
