CONSULTATION ON OPTIONS FOR THE POSSIBLE EXPANSION OF JUNIOR SCHOOLS FROM SEPTEMBER 2015

As you may be aware, there has been a rising demand for primary school places in the Borough in recent years. This could continue for the foreseeable future. We have therefore increased the number of primary school places to meet this demand starting with the first phase of the Primary Expansion Programme from September 2011, followed by further phases of expansion from September 2012 and 2013. When the programme is completed an additional 18 forms of entry (FE) will have been provided which will have required investment of just over £60m. In all, 15 primary schools have been expanded so far of which 3 are infant schools. It is now necessary to make the necessary arrangements for the expansion of their linked junior schools. These places will come into operation from September 2015. We believe that through expansion of these schools we will be able to place every Sutton child requiring a school place.

We are now consulting with a wide range of interested parties including parents, carers and professionals working in education and related sectors to find out their views on the suggestions for the expansion of the junior schools set out in this document.

I am pleased to let you have a copy of our consultation document. We have also included at Appendix 1 a response form for you to use.

1. INTRODUCTION

This consultation document explains the Local Authority's proposals to create additional places in Year Three (Y3) at three junior schools for September 2015. Your views are important to us, so please take the opportunity to express your opinion on the proposals in this document.

2. THE CONSULTATION PROCESS

There will be a number of public consultation meetings arranged to look at expansion of schools in general but, in particular, the proposals as they relate to the junior school at which the meeting is held. All meetings will, however, be open to all parents, including those of the linked infant school, along with members of the public who are interested in finding out more about the proposals.

Following the end of this period of public consultation, a report will be submitted to the Council's Children, Families and Education Committee (CFEC) at its 13 March 2014 meeting detailing responses received and any issues raised during the consultation period. The CFEC will consider these responses before deciding whether to take the proposals forward through the publication of Statutory Proposals, which are formal legal documents in which the precise changes to be made are set out. Following this stage, the Council would be in a position to take the final decision as to which schools to take forward for expansion for September 2015 during the summer 2014 term.

3. THE PROPOSALS

Schools proposed for expansion in 2015

Following the expansion of their feeder infant schools in 2012 and 2013, further discussions have been reopened with the governors of 3 junior schools where the increased Key Stage 1 year groups will be feeding through into Key Stage 2 by September 2015. There will therefore be a need for expansion by 1 FE (i.e. the provision of additional accommodation coupled with an increase in the Published Admission Number (PAN) of 30) to accommodate these larger year groups.

The following schools are being considered for expansion by September 2015:

Cheam Common Junior (90 to 120 places at Y3 per year) Federation of St Elphege's Catholic Schools - Junior (64 to 96 places at Y3 per year) St Mary's Catholic Junior (60 to 90 places at Y3 per year)

The proposed expansions of the three junior schools will all require significant enlargement in the physical capacity of the school's buildings through a major building project. In addition, for each of the schools involved, expansion will require an increase in the Published Admission Number (PAN) with effect from September 2015. In the case of Cheam Common Junior, the Local Authority is responsible for the admission arrangements but in the case of St Elphege's and St Mary's, because they are Catholic Voluntary Aided schools, the Governing Body is the Admission Authority.

Discussions will continue with respective governing bodies with regard to the precise nature of the enlargement projects which will lead to feasibility work being commissioned in relation to the additional accommodation that will be required.

4. SPECIFIC CONSULTEES
