- 6 Reducing the harmful effects of transport on health and the environment and mitigating its impact on climate change

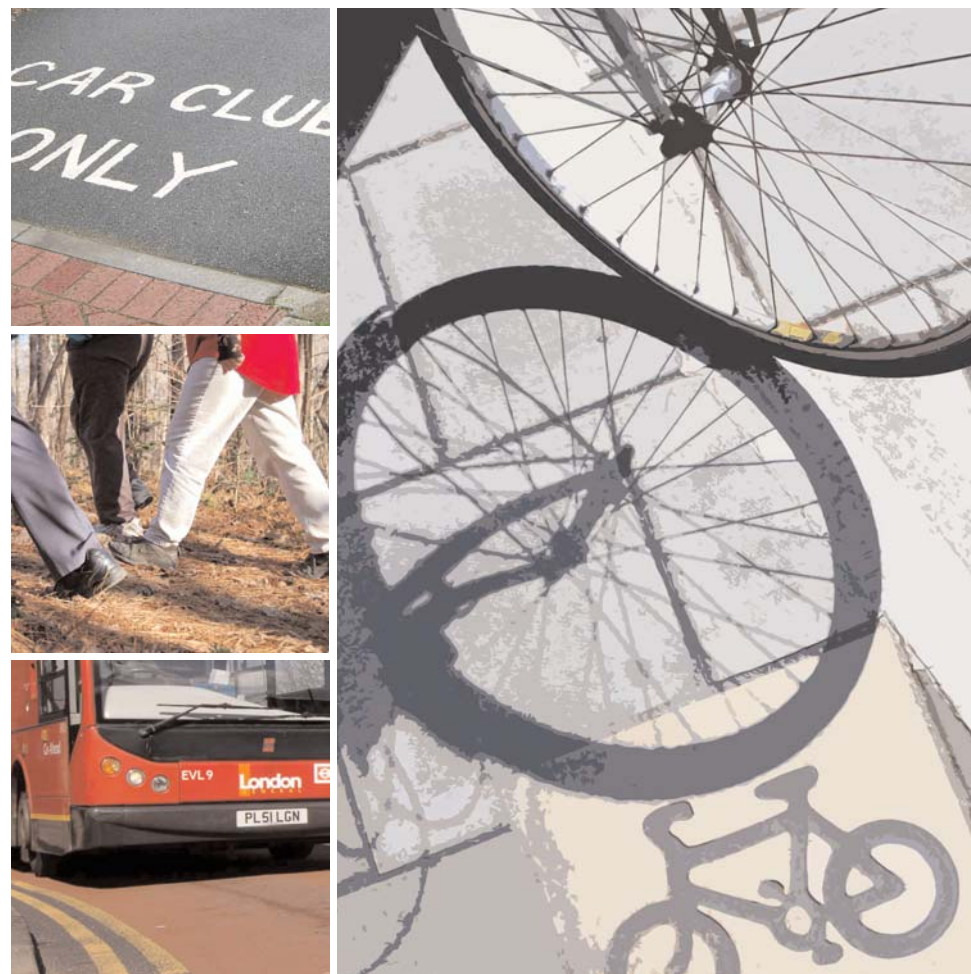
We want your views

Sutton's Transport Plan identifies the council's transport strategy and objectives covering the three financial years from 2011/12 to 2013/14, and sets out a programme of transport schemes to achieve these.



It serves as the council's Local Implementation Plan (LIP), a statutory document which sets out the targets and measures required to implement the Mayor of London's Transport Strategy, published in May 2010.

The plan focuses on the delivery of a number of Integrated Transport Packages in District Centres, as well as these schemes:

- Beddington Lane Improvement Scheme
- Cycle Training
- Bus Stop Accessibility
- Cycle Network Improvements
- Local Safety Schemes
- Home Zones and 20mph Zones
- Principal Road Maintenance
