The purpose of the Order is as follows:-

'A 20mph speed limit on roads in the area will reduce vehicle speeds and improve the environment to encourage more people to walk or cycle as part of their journey'.

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF SUTTON, having consulted with the Commissioner of the Metropolitan Police, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84 and 124 of, and Part III of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended by The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Amendment) Order 1999(b), the Local Government Act 1985(c) and Part II of the Road Traffic Act 1991(d) and all other powers so enabling hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as **The Sutton (Speed Limit) (20 mph) (Sutton South Area) (No. \*) Order 202\*** and shall come into operation on **\*\* Month 202\***.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(e) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (4) "special forces" means those units of the home forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to motor vehicles used for naval, military or air force purposes if being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when:
- (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces; and
- (b) the vehicle is being driven:
  - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
  - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
