

## Denmark Gardens

### Proposed changes to recycling and rubbish storage

<b>Proposed change</b> <i>(also see attached maps for details)</i>	<b>Benefits</b>
Remove the blue-lidded paper and card recycling wheelie bins (17 in total) located around Denmark Gardens. Replace with six larger paper and card recycling bins located in five 'recycling areas'.	More space for recycling - increases the amount of space for paper and card from 53 litres per household to 57 litres per household. Larger (1100-litre) recycling bins provide more flexible space for large cardboard boxes.  Removing 17 wheelie bins from communal areas will improve how the estate looks.
Locate the bins for paper and card recycling in the same places as the bins used to recycle plastics, glass, cans and cartons.	Makes recycling more convenient as the key recycling bins will be located together.
Create a new recycling area next to the stairwell of Block 85-96 (this area is already used to store rubbish bins). Lower the kerb and install a hard standing area (paving) for the bins to stand on.	Provides easy access to recycling facilities for residents living in numbers 37-42, 43-54 and 85-96. Hard standing area and lowered kerb will provide improved access for crews on collection day.
Create a hard-standing area next to the bicycle shed (outside Block 25-30) to improve access to the new extended recycling area.	Provides better access to the recycling bins, for residents and collection crews.
Replace all existing recycling bins (x11) with new, improved bins.	Apertures (openings) in the lids of the new bins are designed to improve the quality of the recycling collected.
Install new signs in recycling areas and new recycling information stickers on all bins.	Providing clearer information to residents about what can and cannot be recycled.
Place 'rubbish only' stickers on chute doors and rubbish bins.	A reminder that only household waste that can't be recycled should be placed in the chutes or rubbish bins.
