Proposed changes to recycling and rubbish storage

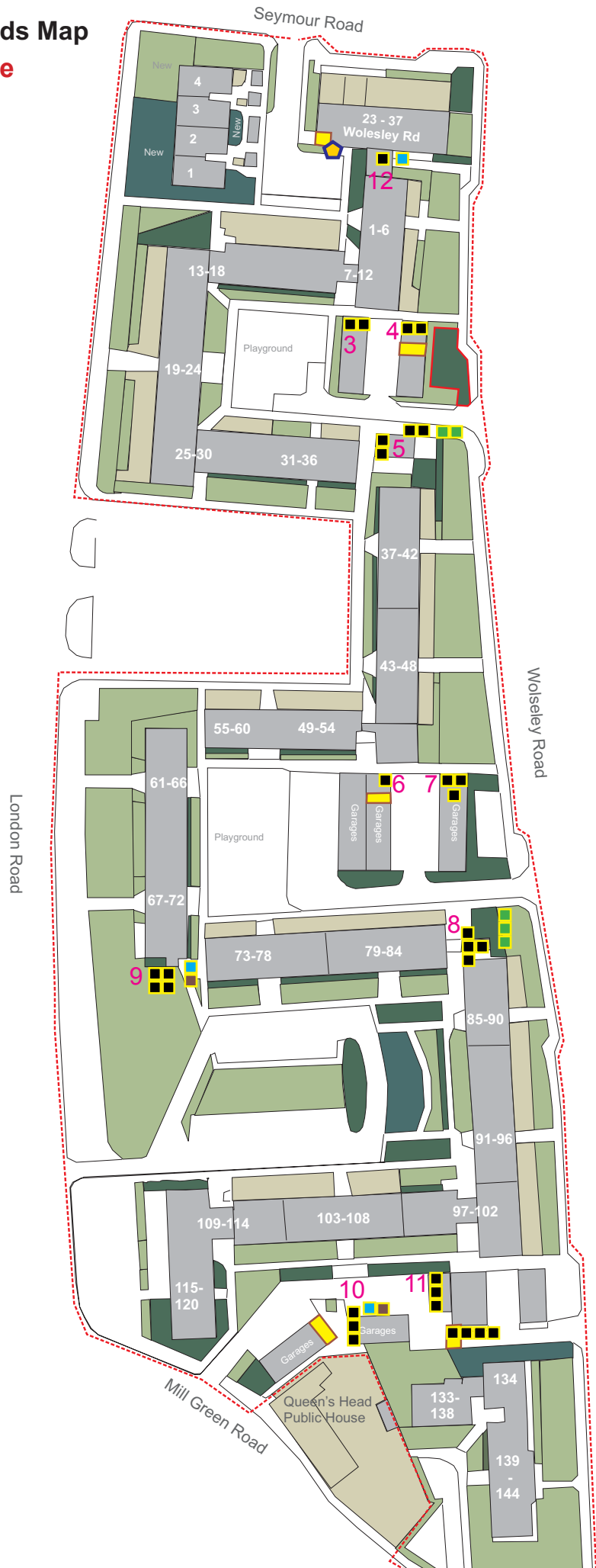
Proposed change <i>(also see attached maps)</i>	Benefits
Increase capacity for paper and card recycling - replace three small wheelie bins with eight larger paper and card bins.	Provides enough bins for residents of Mill Green to start recycling paper and card properly.
Increase the number of recycling bins for plastics, glass, cans and cartons from five to eight.	Provides enough space for everyone on Mill Green to start recycling more.
Create a new recycling area next to Bin Stores 10 and 11 (see attached map for details).	Provides easy access to recycling facilities for residents living in the north of the estate. Increased capacity for recycling in the north of the estate will free up space for rubbish, preventing overfills and helping control vermin.
Move the recycling bins from outside Bin Room 5 (on the corner of Wolseley Road) to a new recycling area next to Block 37-42 (see map for details).	More space for additional recycling bins. Improves the visual environment at one of the key entry points (Wolseley Road) for the estate.
Reduce the amount of space for rubbish from 31 bins to 25 bins across the estate. Change Bin Stores 4 and 7 into recycling-only areas.	Encourages all residents to recycle household waste by providing much more space for recycling and little less space for rubbish.
Replace all existing recycling bins with new, improved bins.	Apertures (openings) in the lids of the new bins are designed to improve the quality of the recycling collected.
Install new signs in recycling areas and new recycling information stickers on all bins.	Providing clearer information about what can and cannot be recycled.
Place 'rubbish only' stickers on chute doors and rubbish bins.	A reminder that only household waste that can't be recycled should be placed in the chutes or rubbish bins.
